3. USE OF TECHNOLOGY - Online Learning for Religious Education

Although I anticipate that Religious Education classes will be held face-to-face, there may be times where virtual classes are necessary. In that event St. John Vianney Parish is committed to make every effort to ensure a safe learning environment for our Religious Education Program, and our Catechists will conform to the Altoona-Johnstown Diocese's "Guidelines and Standards of Our Youth Protection Plan and Technology Agreement." For your part, the Code of Conduct below is to make you and your child aware of the behavioral expectations for those times we need to move to on-line learning. Please read & sign the "Code of Conduct" below.

AS THE PARENT/GUARDIAN OF THE CHILD LISTED ABOVE, I understand that my child may participate in some on-line learning for the 2022-2023 school year for Religious Education at St. John Vianney Parish. I agree that, if necessary, my child may participate in the appointed on-line classes and complete the expected assignments and return them as instructed in order to receive credit for Religious Education for this year.

My child and I agree to these basic on-line learning "Code of Conduct Protocols":

- Use the same respect & positive behavior as during in-person instruction.
- If possible, participate in a quiet place with easy parent access.
- Be on time for each scheduled session.
- Have the necessary book, papers, pens & resources ready and on their desk.
- Use their full name and have no inappropriate backgrounds.
- Remain on "mute" and only "un-mute" when called to do so (or raise hand to do so).
- Be appropriately dressed (no pajamas or sleepwear).
- Preferably not participate from the child's bedroom unless seated at a desk.
- No eating or drinking during the session except unless necessary for water.
- The virtual link is for the student only and not to be shared.
- Any pranks, hacking, or disruption of the lesion will result in the session's immediate termination by the Catechist.
- Remain seated, fully engaged and visible throughout the session and refrain from getting up and down or moving the computer.
- In the event my child cannot participate, I will provide the appropriate notice as instructed by the parish and ensure that the make-up is completed and returned.
